## The Annual Parish Meeting 2010 Minutes

Held in the Village Hall on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2010 at 8.00 pm.

- 1. Minutes of the meetings held on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2009**  
Cllr R Lewis proposed accepting the minutes: all in favour (Cllr Dawson abstained as not present at the 2009 meeting).
- 2. Annual report of the Parish Council for 2009/2010**  
Filed with the minutes. Cllr Harji seconded Cllr Davis' thanks to those involved in getting the allotments up and running. Cllr R Lewis credited Cllr Davis for getting the allotments and play area through despite their contentious natures. Cllr F Lewis proposed a vote of thanks to Cllr Davis.
- 3. Finance accounts of the Parish Council year ending 31st March 2010**  
Cllr R Lewis proposed agreeing the accounts and sections 1 and 2 of the Annual Report: all in favour. Cllr Boura proposed a vote of thanks to the Clerk.
- 4. Parish Council communications (website and Barton Miller)**  
It was suggested that more contact details for councillors should be included in the Barton Miller. Cllr F Lewis suggested a full list of councillors without their contact details should be published; Cllr Boura thought the website address should also be included.
